In 2017 the Foundation started a new fund called the **Compassionate Care Fund**. The fund is used to purchase those items that do not make it on the Hospital priority list, but are a priority for the comfort and care of our patients and their families.

For example, funds from the **Compassionate Care Fund** were used to purchase an iPad for the long term care unit. The iPad is used to help in cognitive therapy.

Most recently, the Foundation purchased a new recliner for the interim long-term care unit. The focus of the **Compassionate Care Fund** is to make our patient stays as comfortable as possible.

# Your Donations In Action

In 2017, funds from the Foundation purchased the following:

- **\$10,000** for physiotherapy equipment
- **\$600,000** to the Clinic Modernization Project

The Foundation continues to raise funds in support of the clinic renovation project at the Hospital. We are currently sitting at 60 per cent of our fundraising goal of \$1 million. The new clinics will provide the space needed to bring new specialists to Kemptville.

Also to be housed in the new clinic space is a COPD clinic, thanks to proceeds from the Bob Perry Memorial Golf Tournament.

- **\$158,000** for a new mobile (digital) x-ray machine

The mobile x-ray machine is used when a patient, either in the emergency room (ER) or on the ward, is too ill to be moved to the diagnostic imaging department. In the operating room (OR), the mobile x-ray machine is brought in during surgery when the surgeon requires an immediate x-ray to determine the best course of treatment.



Our old portable x-ray machine was over twelve years old and the technology was extremely out-of-date.

In the many instances where this portable x-ray machine is used, the situation is often traumatic and time can make a critical difference in the successful diagnosis and treatment of a patient.

With the new digital technology, the x-ray provides an incredibly clear and concise image, far superior to current technology, ensuring more accurate injury diagnosis.

Most importantly, our patients will not have to wait in pain while x-rays are being developed.

# Stories From The Garden

When Edward Chajkowski and his wife Nancy moved to Kemptville in 1975, they wasted no time in getting involved in the community. Ed volunteered with many organizations, including 17 years with Home Support. In 2000, Ed was awarded Citizen of the Year by the Chamber of Commerce. Nancy became a volunteer with the Auxiliary at the Hospital and started the Auxiliary gift shop. Nancy went on to serve as Chair of the Hospital Board. "The Hospital held a very special place in her heart," recounts Ed. "Her whole life was the hospital". Sadly, Nancy passed away in 2006 from cancer. Her legacy lives on in the Hospital Auxiliary gift shop, which continues to successfully raise funds in support of the Hospital. As well as Ed's volunteer commitments in the community, his financial commitments to the hospital foundation are also important to him. "It feels so good to know that our hospital is right here when we need it." Ed's daily walks take him by the hospital, where he will often stop to admire the garden on the front lawn and visit the memorial stone he placed in the garden in memory of his loved ones. Ed feels very lucky to have had the opportunity to live and raise his children in Kemptville. Giving back to the community through volunteering and philanthropy is his way to say thank you to the community that means so much to him and his family.
